URBAN EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES WITH DR. BECKY

GUIDELINES:

Visiting dogs must be kept on a leash. All visitors must sign a waiver at the office before riding or working with your horse.

DELIVERIES:

When ordering hay bales to be delivered to your stall please place orders before 2 p.m.

ARENA ETIQUETTE: (Order of Priority)

- Riding takes precedence over lunging, turnouts, and hand walking.
- Horses being ridden Left shoulder to left shoulder as a general rule.
 Beginners don't always know how to steer please be patient and ride around them.
- 3) Lunging If riders are present ask if it's OK to lunge before doing so.
- 4) Turn Outs Please attend to your horse and limit your time to 15 minutes. Be courteous when others are waiting. If you ARE waiting, be by the gate and let the handler in the arena know.
- Always be courteous to other boarders and guests.

FACILITIES RULES AND USE:

When riding outside of the arenas, horses are to be ridden at the walk only. No riding in the barn.

Jumps in the English/Santiago arena are specifically placed and must be left where they are found. Any horses turned out in the English/Santiago arena must be supervised and kept from damaging the jumps.
