Hernando Cortez sailed to the New World in 1519. One of the horses on the expedition was described as a "pinto with white stockings on his forefeet". Another was a "dark roan horse" with "white patches". These were the first known recorded description of early Paint horses in the New World. As horses spread across the West, Comanche Indians favored the loud colored horses and had many in their herds.

These spotted horses were called pinto, paint, skewbald and piebald. The Paint Horse registry was established in 1962 dedicated to preserving both the color and stock-type conformation. An American Paint Horse comes in a variety of colors in combination with white. Markings can be any shape or size and located anywhere on the body. Coat patterns are varied and are either overo, tobiano, tovero or solid. Paint Horses have a stock-horse type conformation, athletic ability and versatility and a good disposition

Paint or Pinto? A pinto differs from a Paint solely due to bloodlines. A pinto may be any breed or combination of breeds. Many breeds carry pinto patterns. While pinto colored horses are not a specific breed, several breed registries have been formed. Pinto coloring is rare in the wild. A registered Paint must have a registered American Quarter Horse, American Paint horse or Thoroughbred parents. Paint horses could be registered as pintos, but not all pintos qualify to be registered as Paints.
