Percherons – A Weighty Subject

The Percheron breed is considered to have originated in Le Perche France, which is about 50 miles southwest of Paris. The Percheron forerunners are believed to go back hundreds of years to ancient time.



Traditionally, Percherons have been primarily grey or white and were favored as coach horses due to their easy visibility at night. Today, Percherons are usually black or grey, but also come in sorrels, bays and roans. During the 1880's, thousands of Percherons were imported to the United States as their superiority as draft animals was discovered.

They range in height from 15 to 19 hands tall and can weigh over 2500 pounds, though the average is about 1900 pounds. They generally have very calm dispositions.
