Arabian horses originated in the Arabian Peninsula thousands of years ago. The Arab's hardiness is a result of the harsh desert climate and terrain they evolved in. They are used to improve other breeds by adding speed, refinement and endurance, and are ancestors of many modern horses.

Arabian horses have compact bodies with short backs and powerful hindquarters. Elegant arched necks, fine silky manes and tails and a refined head with featuring large eyes and nostrils completes the overall picture. Altogether their appearance is one of refinement, power, agility, and elegance. Arabians excel in almost every horse sport. They dominate the field of endurance riding and are one of the top ten most popular horses in the world.

Most Arabian horses are between 14 hands and 15.2 hands. They are fine to medium boned and weigh from 800 lbs to 1000 lbs. A dished face and high tail carriage are distinct characteristic of all Arabians. Most are bay, gray, chestnut, and more rarely, black or roan, and can have all types of white facial markings, and white socks or stockings on their legs. They all have black skin, regardless of coat color, except under white markings.

Arabians have naturally good dispositions and are classified as a "hot-blooded" horse. - Mia
