Art and Guapo

A Cow Horse (aka Cow Pony, aka Ranch Horse) is one that is mostly used on ranches to work cattle. The definition of a cow horse is a small, fast, agile horse used for herding cattle.

Cow horses were developed by crossing Quarter horses with various Spanish horses that had come from Indian tribes, most notably the Chickasaw.

Today's cow horses resulted from these horses plus selective breeding specifically for cow sense. A good Cow horse must be fast on its feet and alert to both the slightest of rider commands, and able to sense a cow's move before the cow actually makes the move.

A Cow horse has the same basic conformation, abilities and attitude as a Quarter horse. They come in all colors, with sorrel being the most common. Cow horses have a well-muscled body and a good disposition and are versatile horses. They are used in a wide variety of ways in the horse world. Because of their calm manner, they are good choices for trail riding and make excellent pleasure horses.

The gelding shown is typical of a desired cow horse with a very calm demeanor.
