The American Quarter Horse is an American horse breed and is the most popular breed in the United States today. Rodeos and races are what most people think of when they hear the words quarter horse but the horses are much more than that. American Quarter Horses trace their roots to Arab, Turkish and Barb breeds that were brought to North America by Spanish explorers and traders.



The modern Quarter Horse has a small, short refined head with a straight profile and a strong, well-muscled body. It has a broad chest and powerful rounded hindquarters. They generally stand between 14 and 16 hands high with weights ranging from 800 to 1000 lbs. Racing and hunter-type Quarter horses are leaner and taller than working Quarter horses but still have muscular hindquarters and powerful legs.

The American Quarter Horse is known as a race horse, a rodeo horse, a working ranch horse and general show horse. They are also often used as trail horses and by mounted police. Because of its compact conformation, it is extremely agile and quick.

Quarter Horses come in nearly all colors though the most common color is sorrel. They have a heavily muscled body, an even disposition, excellent athletic ability and are extremely versatile animals. The mare shown above is an excellent example of a Quarter Horse. - Mea
